

Curriculum Snapshot/Cover Page for



German 3/4 (H) - Year B

Unit 1: L2, Chapter 5-Eating Healthily

20 Days Students will learn vocabulary and expressions related to eating, with an emphasis on healthy eating habits. Students will be able to express regret and downplay, express skepticism, verify statements, and talk about foods and eating habits in greater detail. Grammatical concepts focused on are the declension of demonstrative pronouns, declension of possessive pronouns, and the declension of interrogatives.



Unit 2: L2, Chapter 6-Get Well Soon!

20 Days Students will learn vocabulary and expressions related to inquiring about someone's health, responding to inquiries about health, making suggestions, asking about and expressing discomfort and various health conditions, asking for and giving advice, and expressing positive sentiments with regard to recovery. Grammatical concepts focused on are verbs used with dative case forms, reflexive verbs used with the dative case, and use of subordinate clauses.



Unit 3: L2, Chapter 8-Fashion? Yes or No?

20 Days Students will learn vocabulary and expressions related to describing clothes; espressing interest, disinterest, and indifference; making and accepting compliments; and expressions related to persuasion and dissuasion.

Grammatical concepts focused on are the declension of adjectives following demonstratives, verbs requiring reflexive pronouns in the accusative and dative cases, and irregular verbs.

Unit 4: L2, Chapter 12-The Reinickendorfer Clique

20 Days Students will learn vocabulary and expressions related to the reporting of past events; asking for, making, and responding to suggestions; ordering food; expressing hearsay and regret; expressing preference; and expressing interest, disinterest, and indifference. Grammatical concepts focused on are past participles and helping verbs, "polite" request verb forms, and comparative adjectival forms.



Unit 5: L3, Chapter 2-Off to the Youth Hostel!

20 Days Students will learn vocabulary and expressions related to asking for and making suggestions, expressing preferences, expressing wishes, doubt, resignation and conviction. Grammatical concepts focused on are wocompounds, use of subordinate clauses, and hätte and würde forms.



Unit 6: L3, Chapter 4-Relationships to Others

20 Days Students will learn vocabulary and expressions related to hypothesizing, agreement, giving advice, and introducing other points of view. Grammatical concepts focused on are relative clauses, declension of ordinal numbers, and the genitive case.
