

Reavis High School Curriculum Snapshot/Cover Page for German I



Unit 1: Introduction to German and Who Are You?

20 Days Students will be able to say hello and goodbye, ask someone's name and give theirs, and ask who someone is. Students will also be able to ask someone's age and give theirs, talk about places of origin, and talk about getting to school. Grammatical concepts focused on are forming questions, the definite articles *der*, *die* and *das*, the subject pronouns, and the verb forms of *sein*.

Unit 2: Fun and Games

20 Days Students will be able to talk about interests, express likes and dislikes, and say when they do various activities. Students will also be able to ask for an opinion and express theirs, and agree and disagree. Grammatical concepts focused on are the present tense verb forms, German word order, and verbs with stems ending in *d*, *t*, or *n*.

Unit 3: Come Home with Me!

20 Days Students will be able to talk about where they and others live, offer something to eat and drink, respond to an offer, and say please, thank you, and you're welcome. Students will also be able to describe a room, their family, and other people. Grammatical concepts focused on are the verb forms of möchte, the indefinite articles ein and eine, the pronouns er, sie, es and sie (pl.), and the possessive adjectives mein, sein, dein, and ihr.

Unit 4: Everything for School!

20 Days Students will be able to talk about class schedules, use a schedule to talk about time, and use words to sequence events. Students will also be able to express likes, dislikes, and favorites, respond to good news and bad news, talk about prices, and point things out.

Grammatical concepts focused on are the verb forms of haben, the prefix Lieblings-, and making nouns plural.



Unit 5: Buying Clothes

20 Days Students will be able to express wishes when shopping, and comment on and describe clothes. Students will also be able to give compliments, respond to them, and talk about trying on clothes. Grammatical concepts focused on are definite and indefinite articles, the accusative case, the verb *gefallen*, direct object pronouns, separable-prefix verbs, and the stemchanging verbs *nehmen* and *aussehen*.



Unit 6: Making Plans

20 Days Students will be able to start a conversation, tell time, talk about when they do things, make plans, and order food and beverages. Students will also be able to talk about how something tastes and pay the check. Grammatical concepts focused on are the verb forms of wollen and the stem-changing verb essen.



Unit 7: Helping Out at Home

20 Days Students will be able to extend and respond to an invitation, express obligations, and talk about how often they do things. Students will also be able to offer help, explain what to do, and talk about the weather. Grammatical concepts focused on are the verb forms of müssen and können, the accusative pronouns mich, dich, uns, and euch, and using the present tense to express the future.



Unit 8: Going Shopping

20 Days Students will be able to ask what they should do, tell someone what to do, talk about quantities, and say they want something else. Students will also be able to give reasons and say where they were/what they bought. Grammatical concepts focused on are the verb forms of *sollen*, the *du* and *ihr* commands, the conjunctions *weil* and *denn*, and the past tense of the verb *sein*.
