#### Unit 1: Intro To Psychology

15-17 Days Students will understand why we study psychology and what psychologists do. They will be introduced to a brief history of psychology and contemporary perspectives of psychology. Students will understand how psychologists use the scientific method and scientific inquiry to explain human behavior. The Scientific Method will be introduced.

#### Unit 2: Neuroscience and Behavior

12-15 Days Students will gain a better understanding of the nervous system, the brain, and how heredity shapes human thoughts and behaviors. Students will understand how sensation and perception are critical to understanding and living in our enviornment. Students will be able to identify parts of the neuron, the brain and their functions.

### **Unit 3: Personality**

15-20 Days Students will understand what drives human behavior. They will be able to describe the variety of approaches and tests that are used to explain personality. Students will understand how gender roles and behavior develop.

#### Unit 4: Psychological Disorders

18-20 Days

Students will understand how stress produces psychological and physical effects on the body. Students will gain a better understanding of what psychological disorders are and how they are classified. The students will understand how mental health professionals help people with psychological disorders.
