100% Remote Learning Information

- Classes end at **12:55 p.m.** All students must be in attendance virtually Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.
- There will be a **5 minute transition period** between each virtual class.
- ALL students must log into e-Learning by **8:00 a.m.** Students will do this on our website. <https://sites.google.com/reavid220.org/elearning/home>
- **Students MUST check their Gmail every day. ZOOM/Google Meet links will be posted to Schoology or may be sent to the student's Gmail accounts.**
- Teachers will take attendance via PowerSchool during every virtual class.
- Student attendance is mandatory for all virtual classes.
- Students will need to charge their device each day. **All technology questions should be directed to SOS@d220.org.**
- Requests for in-person intervention time should be done through the counselor/teacher.
- I & E time is dedicated to **intervention** and **enrichment**. It is an opportunity for students to engage with the teacher if/when they need extra help or opportunities for enrichment. Students can be assigned to an I & E period virtually or in-person to make up work, work in partners or small groups to accomplish collaborative work (via Zoom breakouts), get extra help, or for a reteaching session--among other things. Students can also *request* to attend an I & E period, but they should do so a day in advance so their teacher(s) can plan for them.
