Dear 2015 Graduate and Parents:

The Class of 2015 Commencement Ceremony will be held in the Main Gym on Saturday, May 23, 2015, at 10:00 a.m. Graduating seniors are to meet in the Multi-Purpose Room on that day at 9:00 a.m. Students will receive graduation tickets at the graduation practice held on Friday, May 22, 2015.

Graduates will receive four (4) tickets for the graduation ceremony in the Main Gym. In addition, arrangements have been made for our Communications Club to simultaneously broadcast the graduation ceremony in the Grossman Auditorium. As a result of these arrangements, we will supply our graduates with three (3) additional tickets for seating in the Auditorium. This has worked wonderfully in past years, especially for senior citizens and small children, and we are sure your guests will be pleased.

Please remember to share the following procedures and guidelines with your graduation guests. They will be enforced for your comfort and safety:

- **No one** will be admitted late once the procession begins. Please allow ample time for parking.
- **No one** will be admitted into the ceremony without a ticket. This includes children.
- **No one** will be readmitted if they leave in the middle of the ceremony.
- Special seating will be provided **only** for the disabled.
- Aisles must be kept open; exits must remain clear.
- A-L seating will be on the North side of the bleachers.
M-Z seating will be on the South side of the bleachers.
- Video cameras will **not** be allowed on the floor. You may videotape from your seat.
Tripods will NOT be allowed in the gym.
- **Strollers will NOT be allowed in the gym. We encourage small children to be seated in the Auditorium.**
- **If you are bringing flowers and/or balloons for your graduate to the ceremony, please remember to check them at the ENTRANCE. You will be able to pick them up immediately after the ceremony.**

For your benefit, we have made arrangements with Visual Image Photography, Inc. (VIP) to have a professional photographer take a picture of every graduate when he/she receives a diploma. VIP will mail a postcard to all families with online proofs and ordering information after graduation. We feel this service will enable all parents to have a picture of their graduate while providing a dignified atmosphere. Parents are encouraged to relax in their seats and limit their personal picture taking to before or after the presentation of diplomas. As an extra service, we have also made arrangements with Zaker Video Productions to record this year's graduation ceremony. Information about the cost of this service is included with this letter.

Friday, May 15, 2015 - LAST DAY FOR SENIORS

Thursday, May 21, 2015 - SENIOR CHECK OUT DAY - Auditorium

Students whose last name begins with **A - L** (8:00 a.m. to 9:15 a.m.)

Students whose last name begins with **M- Z** (9:15 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.)

Attendance is mandatory.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be a \$25 charge for ANY Senior that does NOT attend Senior Check Out.

Senior Check Out includes graduation certification by your counselor and payment of outstanding fees and library fines (CASH ONLY). This is also the ONLY TIME you may pick up your cap and gown.

Friday, May 22, 2015 - GRADUATION REHEARSAL - Main Gym

(8:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.)

Attendance is mandatory for all graduating seniors who wish to participate in the ceremony. If you do not wish to participate, you may pick up your diploma in the Guidance Office on Tuesday, May 26th.

At the rehearsal, you will receive your tickets and final information about the graduation ceremony. **Graduates will be given FOUR (4) TICKETS for the Main Gym and THREE (3) for the Auditorium for the video simulcast. No one will be admitted without a ticket - even small children need a ticket.**

A group panoramic picture of the Class of 2015 will be taken at 8:00 a.m. **sharp** prior to the rehearsal.

Saturday, May 23, 2015 - GRADUATION DAY - Main Gym

Graduating seniors are to meet in the Multi-Purpose Room at 9:00 a.m. **sharp!** Graduates should park in the Drivers Ed Range and enter the school at the Patio. Graduates will be expected to dress appropriately for this very important day in their lives. **NO SOCKS, NO SHIRT, NO DIPLOMA! Shorts are inappropriate and not allowed.**

You may pick up your group picture in the Multi-Purpose Room after the Commencement Ceremony. The cost is \$20.00 for a laminated photograph.

VIP Visual Imaging Photography, Inc. will be taking photos as each graduate receives his/her diploma. You will be receiving information in the mail from VIP regarding this service.
