DRIVER'S EDUCATION SUMMER SCHOOL, 2023 GENERAL FACTS

WHO MAY TAKE DRIVER'S EDUCATION IN SUMMER SCHOOL?

Only students legally residing in District #220 may take Driver Education at Reavis who will be 15 years old by April 28, 2023.

THE FOLLOWING THREE TYPES OF STUDENTS MAY TAKE SUMMER DRIVER'S EDUCATION:

- 1. Any Reavis student who does not wish to take Driver's Education during the regular school year.
- 2. Reavis students who have failed Driver's Education during the regular school year.
- 3. Private school students Students who live in District #220 who do not attend Reavis High School during the regular year.

WHEN DOES DRIVER'S EDUCATION TAKE PLACE?

- 1. Registration begins April 10 and ends April 17, and will close early if the class seats are full.
- 2. CLASS BEGINS ON WEDNESDAY, May 31, and END ON THURSDAY, JUNE 22.
- 3. Summer Driver's Education candidates (except regular year failures) <u>MUST</u> attend two meetings on April 18 at RAM in the Auditorium and on April 28 at 11:00 am in the student cafeteria.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

- 1. A check, cash or money order in the amount of \$200.00 <u>MUST BE SUBMITTED IN FULL</u> with the Summer School registration form.
- 2. At the April 28 meeting, a \$20.00 check or money order should be made out to: "SECRETARY OF STATE OF ILLINOIS." (License/Permit Fee)
