DRIVER'S EDUCATION SUMMER SCHOOL, 2023 *GENERAL FACTS*

WHO MAY TAKE DRIVER'S EDUCATION IN SUMMER SCHOOL?

Only students legally residing in District #220 may take Driver Education at Reavis who will be 15 years old by April 28, 2023.

THE FOLLOWING THREE TYPES OF STUDENTS MAY TAKE SUMMER DRIVER'S EDUCATION:

1. Any Reavis student who does not wish to take Driver's Education during the regular school year.
2. Reavis students who have failed Driver's Education during the regular school year.
3. Private school students - Students who live in District #220 who do not attend Reavis High School during the regular year.

WHEN DOES DRIVER'S EDUCATION TAKE PLACE?

1. Registration begins April 10 and ends April 17, and will close early if the class seats are full.
2. CLASS BEGINS ON WEDNESDAY, May 31, and END ON THURSDAY, JUNE 22.
3. Summer Driver's Education candidates (except regular year failures) MUST attend two meetings on April 18 at RAM in the Auditorium and on April 28 at 11:00 am in the student cafeteria.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

1. A check, cash or money order in the amount of \$200.00 MUST BE SUBMITTED IN FULL with the Summer School registration form.
2. At the April 28 meeting, a \$20.00 check or money order should be made out to:
"SECRETARY OF STATE OF ILLINOIS." (License/Permit Fee)
