Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your student is currently enrolled in the Blended Learning U.S. Government and/or Economics course that will be held July 13-30. Before class starts on Monday, July 13th, we wanted to make sure you understand aspects of this unique course.

## WHAT IS BLENDED LEARNING?

Blended learning is a course that is delivered in a “blended” environment that includes face-to-face instruction and online delivery of lessons. Blended learning allows for flexible scheduling by students and teachers to complete the same set of content standards that would be delivered in a traditional course setting.

## WHAT WILL BLENDED LEARNING LOOK LIKE?

Students should plan on meeting at Reavis for face-to-face learning at the following times:

If a student falls below a 70% on their course work, he/she will be required to attend in person instruction daily from 8:00-11:00 a.m. until they are meeting the success level of the class. All other work will take place online, with students working at their own pace to meet the expectations of the course.
